Executive Summary

This Emergency and Resilience Plan has been designed to allow Parish and Town Councils to populate a more flexible and tailored Resilience Template that would suit a demographic of anything from 500 population to 20,000 population.

Consideration has been given into how a council will identify what is required by them in the support of the Cat 1 and 2 Responders of Emergency Plans and how to help the residence before they arrive.

Emergency and Resilience Plan

The main body of the Emergency and Resilience Plan is to be distributed between the clerk and the council. It gives all the details of why implementation of this needs to be completed, the tasks, people, equipment, skill, support, structure required. Correct resources within a reasonable budget, locations important to the council with instructions from the lead coordinator.

The types of Risks and Hazards, how the council will implement to protect and resolve those hazards and the preplanning required.

Voluntary personnel contact details that are current and regularly audited will need to be implemented as people's circumstances are constantly changing.

The integration of working with Cat 1 and 2 responders of which two of these are County and District Councils.

Village Major Emergency Plan

Included in this pack is a flyer for residence to consider what they need by way of self help, black out considerations and when there are water shortages what you may need.

Encouragement of Residents and Volunteers to support the Emergency Plan.
